

Connecting windows mobile 5

Note: These instructions have been tested on an O2 XDA and on an HP iPaq. They should work equally well on other devices, but there may be some minor detail variations on other platforms


From the **Start menu**, choose **Settings**, and then **Connections**:



Tap **Network Cards** to bring up the **Configure Wireless Networks** screen:



Tap and hold **Imperial-WPA** and choose **Connect** to start the configuration process. Ensure **Connects to:** is **The Internet** then tap **Network Key**:



Under **Authentication**, select **WPA**, and under **Data Encryption**, select **TKIP**. Ensure that **The key is automatically provided** has a tick next to it. Now tap **802.1x**.

Ensure there is a tick next to **Use IEEE 802.1x network access control** and tap **OK**.

Finally, enter your **username**, **password** and **domain (IC)** and tap **OK**. Optionally, click **Save Password** to prevent being prompted again for the information.
